Questions to be Addressed

- How well can turnout in a low-participation special election be predicted? What variables are best used?
- What is the relationship between a Primary and Runoff of a Special Election?
- Despite variability in predictions of raw turnout, how do likely voter universes match the final ethnic, partisan, age composition of the electorate?

Projecting Turnout

- PDI provides clients with likely voter turnout universes for regular statewide and municipal elections and some special elections.
- The Variables best used to determine voter turnout include:
 - Past Vote History (in similar elections)
 - Homeowner/Income Status
 - Age
 - Partisanship (in primaries)
 - PAV particularly Early PAV scores







 - Runoff Arrivals












San Diego City Council Special Election (Age Under 30)









Targeting Still Works

 Despite the variability in raw voter turnout for special elections, the percentages of ethnic/partisan/age turnout can be predicted.
