

PARTY ID IN WASHINGTON




- GOP/Dems at parity in 2000

Purple Dists:2 unchanged;1 more Blue;


4 turned Blue

- No Democrats in Eastern WA outside of Spokane and close suburb (total = 4)




TOTAL VOTE FOR STATE HOUSE




2012 PRESIDENTIAL VOTE BY COUNTY



Clinton: 54%






DENSITY IS DESTINY



- **+700,000** people 2010 2020
- 2/3 in King, Pierce Snohomish (most of rest: Thurston & Clark)
- Current districts good for 2-3 more sessions
- More Legislative seats in Puget Sound
- Congressional districts migrate west



DENSITY IS DESTINY




- Increasing population balance favoring Cities, Suburbs




I-1634: GROCERY TAX BAN






I-1631: CARBON TAX




